## Requirements for Admission as a Transfer Student

Students meeting the minimum requirements listed below will be eligible to attend the University of Florida, Computer and Information Science and Engineering Department (CISE) as a transfer student where they can earn a Bachelor of Science in Computer Engineering. The minimum requirements vary depending on whether a student is transferring from a Florida Community College or another four-year academic institution.

### Minimum Requirements to Transfer

- Completion of an Associate of Arts degree (Florida Community College Students Only)
- An overall 3.0 GPA
- Completion of six of the seven critical tracking courses prior to the first term of enrollment at UF

*\*Although labs are required critical tracking courses, they are not computed in the critical tracking GPA.*

- A combined 2.5 critical tracking GPA throughout the completion of all seven critical tracking courses

*\* Only two tracking courses can be repeated, each one having one additional attempt.*

*\* Additional attempts will be given grade forgiveness within the tracking GPA. However, a grade of C or better must be earned by the second attempt, including withdrawals.*

Students who satisfy the only the minimum requirements will be conditionally accepted into the Computer Science program. All conditionally accepted transfer students are required to complete their remaining tracking course during their first term of enrollment at UF. It is **HIGHLY** recommended that students finish all seven tracking courses prior to their first term of enrollment at UF.
