

COE Constitutional revisions, 2008

1 Existing wording of Section 6.1, Faculty Council

A. The Faculty Council shall be composed of the College of Engineering representatives to the Faculty Senate of the University of Florida except those Senators whose titles contain the words President, Provost, Dean, and/or Chair. In addition, the Dean of the College shall appoint one ex-officio, non-voting member to the Faculty Council.

2 Proposed changes

A. The Faculty Council shall be composed of the College of Engineering representatives to the Faculty Senate of the University of Florida except those Senators whose titles contain the words President, Provost, Dean, and/or Chair. In addition, the Dean of the College shall appoint one ~~ex-officio, non-voting~~ member to the Faculty Council. If the member appointed by the Dean is a faculty member in the College of Engineering with a title that does not contain the words President, Provost, Dean, and/or Chair, then the appointed member shall be a voting member of the Faculty Council; otherwise, the appointed member shall be an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Faculty Council.

3 Proposed clean wording

A. The Faculty Council shall be composed of the College of Engineering representatives to the Faculty Senate of the University of Florida except those Senators whose titles contain the words President, Provost, Dean, and/or Chair. In addition, the Dean of the College shall appoint one member to the Faculty Council. If the member appointed by the Dean is a faculty member in the College of Engineering with a title that does not contain the words President, Provost, Dean, and/or Chair, then the appointed member shall be a voting member of the Faculty Council; otherwise, the appointed member shall be an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Faculty Council.
