









Planned expenditure 2002/3

Aims of programme:

Address the needs of the ageing and disabled population

- Multidisciplinary research
 - Physical science/engineering
 - Social/health/medical science
- Collaborative research
 - Intermediaries, industry, healthcare providers, charities etc.
- Research with a strong user focus
 - Involving older people and disabled people
