What:

UF's Mobile Computing Killer App Competition is organized in connection with the Mobile Platforms [class](#) taught by Professor [Sumi Helal](#) of the [CISE Department](#). The competition is aligned with the class term project in which teams of students pursue their dream apps targeting Android, iOS, Windows Phone or Mobile Web platforms. [Trendy Entertainment](#) – Gainesville's premier mobile gaming company is sponsoring the competition this year, providing cash awards for the top three apps, and a group of volunteer judges led by Mr. Augi Lye, Trendy's Founder and CEO. Established 12 years ago by Professor Helal, the competition has in the past been sponsored three times by Motorola Corp. and once by Microsoft Research.
